11. Carry out clinical teaching in practical labs and work placements.
12. Supervise and assess students whilst in practicing in clinical labs and on clinical placement.
13. Supervise inventory and assist with maintenance of clinical labs.
14. Participate in extra-curricular activities.
15. Assist with pastoral care of students.

Minimum Qualification/Experience Requirements:

Diploma in Environmental Health Sciences and demonstrated aptitude for teaching plus at least five years post qualifying work experience and evidence of continuous professional development.

Candidate must be registered and licensed to practice by the Health Professional Council (HPC).
